



Victory Custom Athletic Uniform Laundry and Care Instructions

Lady Wolfpack issues high quality Victory Custom uniforms to each player. Victory builds the finest quality athletic uniform in the custom uniform industry. **It is each players responsibility to maintain their uniform at the highest standards.** Although the very best in quality and durability is assured, there are certain suggestions that should be followed to maintain the life of a garment.

LAUNDRY PREPARATION

For best results launder uniforms immediately after each wearing. Garments that cannot be washed promptly should be hung individually on rust-proof hangers or hooks. Perspiration fading may occur if wet garments are left in a pile. Inspect garments for tears, snags, etc. before laundering. Repairs should be made prior to washing to prevent further damage. Remove all contrasting color items (belts, gloves, etc.) from garments and wash separately. Before laundering a load of new uniforms test wash one garment according to label directions.

SOAKING

Heavily soiled garments should be soaked in lukewarm water with a protein release agent for a MAXIMUM of 45 minutes. Wash garments in a normal cycle IMMEDIATELY after soaking.

WASHING

Do not wash white and colors together. Was all garments in warm water (110 F) or less. Rinse temperature should be the same as wash. Use a mild (under 10.0ph) detergent. Victory recommends: SPEK-TAC By U.N.X. Inc. which can be purchased direct from Victory Custom. Maintain a high water level in the washing machine to minimize mechanical action. Lower water level to increase mechanical action only when uniforms are extremely soiled. Avoid overloading machine. Use a antistatic dryer sheet or agent on garments to be tumbled dry to minimize lint attraction and electrostatic spark discharge.

BLEACH

DO NOT USE CHLORINE BLEACH as it fades colors and weakens some materials.
DO NOT BLEACH any garment containing braid, trim or embroidery. When bleach is required a all white garment use a light application of an oxygen-based bleach.

DRYING

For best results garments should be hung to dry. When tumble drying use lowest possible temperature or "air only" setting. Remove garments from dryer promptly.

DRY CLEANING

DO NOT DRY CLEAN any uniform

IRONING

In general uniforms should not require ironing. If ironed use low temperature only.

IN SUMMERY

1. Launder whites and darks separately.
2. Do not include any colored cotton items (t-shirts, shorts, socks, etc.) in wash with uniform items
3. Pre-soak and/or treat heavily stained areas.
4. Never use bleach of any kind.
5. Launder in lukewarm water, not hot.
6. Remove all garments immediately after washing.
7. Line dry all garments.
8. Do not dry in machine.
9. Do not iron.
