The Sparkler Tournament Pool Play Schedule is now posted. You will find your schedule listed under your age group. *This is only the pool play schedule. The brackets will be out later this month.* **Your schedule is subject to change as teams drop out of the event.** You will be notified if your schedule is adjusted however please check back from time to time for any changes. You will find a link for the list of the field abbreviations below your schedule link to help you designate which field you will be playing at. I have also attached the field key to this email. Please pass this information onto you parents to help them find what they are looking for.

18 Gold – pool play Tuesday/Wednesday, double elimination brackets start on Thursday-Sunday
18 Open – pool play Tuesday-Thursday. Each team will play two out of the three days. Double elimination brackets start on Friday-Sunday
16 Open - pool play Tuesday-Thursday. Each team will play two out of the three days. Double elimination brackets start on Friday-Sunday
